Methodist church Milan:

The Methodst church in Milan (about 250 members with very different backgrounds) is one of the best laboratories of "Being Church Together", the model of integration with brothers and sisters coming from Methodist Churches (and other Protestant denominations; from Asia, Africa and America) in every part of the world promoted by Methodist and Waldensian Churches in Italy: neither "assimilation" nor "parallel coexistence", but a long term process of mutual integration, an intercultural laboratory, involving both Italians and not Italians to reconsider one's own vocation and to build renewed individual and communal identities and mission, based on a true, open dialogue between different traditions, cultures, liturgical and theological sensitivietis. The congregation is committed in an intensive diaconal work (especially with migrants, refugees); Interprotestant and ecumenical relationships are very intensive and rich.

The candidate has to be open minded. He or she doesn't have to know Italian. Our congregation is bilingual, Italian and English.
