### Course description:

With General Synod 32 (2019) as both an occasion for and subject of our study, we will examine the history, theology, structures, and practice of ministry in today's United Church of Christ. What makes this denomination distinctive and innovative, as well as rooted in tradition?

The major focus of the course will be on the history, and current state, of the discrete traditions which constitute the United Church of Christ. As well, our work will seek to identify those theological and ecclesiological predispositions which are unique to the United Church of Christ. In sum, the course will seek to grapple with the issues of historical and contemporary identity within the United Church of Christ, to prepare the student to be a leader within the Church. The primary objective of this course is to equip students to be competent interpreters of the history, theology, and contemporary identity of the United Church of Christ at an introductory level in multiple settings including congregations, denominational ministry committees and in the public square more generally.
